Information for Parent/Guardians—2025 Contributions and Charges

YEAR 5

The Government provides a comprehensive education that satisfies the requirements of the *Western Australian Curriculum* for all students throughout Western Australia. Government funding is provided to schools for the operating costs associated with the education of students. The costs include salaries of teaching and administrative staff, school buildings and facilities and certain materials. This provision accounts for a significant part of the total State budget. Some school communities also supplement the funds available to them through local fundraising. Each school will determine how the relevant costs are distributed between contributions and charges pursuant to the requirements of the:

School Education Act 1999 and School Education Regulations 2000

Contributions

Middle Swan Primary School voluntary contributions are \$30 per student. It is expected that those who can afford to will make the contribution. Voluntary Contributions can be paid in instalments.

The school can request a contribution of up to \$60 per student per year in Years K-6. This contribution is towards the cost of providing an educational program that meets the requirements of the *Australian Curriculum*. The contributions collected from parents/guardians are used towards providing materials, services and facilities directly used or consumed by students, including hire of textbooks or the provision of text material.

Charges—Please note

Where students elect to participate in extra cost optional components, (eg. Excursions) compulsory charges apply. If payment has not been made by by the closing date (as indicated on permission slip), students will not be permitted to attend excursions/incursions.

Charges apply to high cost options (called extra cost optional components) in Years K-6 that are alternative to parts of the program covered by the contribution. Students can opt to select these.

Extra cost options are also specific activities, services or facilities that schools offer for students to use or take part in. Excursions such as camps, the school photographs and school social activities are examples. Students opt to take part in these activities or use the services or facilities.

The charge associated with the provision of these activities, services or facilities covers the cost of providing the service or running the activity. The school relies on payment for the activity to occur, however often incursion costs are covered by the school for families.
